



Selective Service Registration Status Verification

According to the U.S. Department of Education, you were supposed to have registered for the Selective Service program, but failed to register according to federal law. Men over the age of 26 are no longer allowed to register for Selective Service program and are not eligible to receive federal financial aid. NOTE: Submission of this form does not guarantee the student will become eligible for financial aid at NNMC

IF YOU ARE REGISTERED WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE:

Submit a photocopy of one of the documents listed below to the Financial Aid Office. If you do not have one of the documents listed below, go to www.sss.gov or call the Selective Service Office at (847) 688-6888 to request the required documentation.

- Verification of Registration Form FSF 3-V; or
- Acknowledgment of Registration Form FSF-3B; or
- A letter from the Selective Service

IF YOU ARE NOT REGISTERED AND MEET ONE OF THE FOLLOWING EXEMPTIONS:

Check the appropriate box below, and sign this form and submit it to the Financial Aid Office.

I certify that I am exempt from registration with the Selective Service because (check one):

- I am a female
- I am currently in the armed services on active duty (Note: does not apply to members of the Reserves and National Guard who are not on active duty.)
- I have not reached my 18th birthday
- I was born before 1960
- I am a resident of the Federated States of Micronesia, or the Marshall Islands, or a permanent resident of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands (Palau)

IF YOU ARE NOT REGISTERED AND DO NOT MEET ONE OF THE ABOVE EXEMPTIONS:

- If you are between the ages of 18 and 25, you are required to register with the Selective Service at www.sss.gov
- If you are age 26 or older and are a veteran, military service other than the reserve forces, Delayed Entry Pool or the National Guard please submit a copy of your DD-214 "Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty" to the Financial Aid Office
- If you are age 26 or older and you were 26 or older when you first entered the U.S., you may be exempt. Please submit documentation to verify the date you first entered the U.S. to the Financial Aid Office

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- If you are age 26 or older and you entered the U.S. on a valid non-immigrant visa prior to turning age 26, and you remained in that status until after your 26th birthday, you may be exempt. Please submit documentation to verify your status at the time you turned 26 to the Financial Aid Office

- If you are age 26 or older and you do not fall into one of the above categories, please follow these **instructions:**
 1. Go to www.sss.gov and follow the directions to request a **“Status information Letter”**
 2. When you receive the Status Information Letter from the Selective Service, submit a copy to the Financial Aid Office. You must also provide a signed statement regarding your situation along with this form: List historical timelines and details to help substantiate your situation.
